Chili Cook-Off Entry Rules

Each applicant must register their chili prior to the event. Entry fee is \$30.00 per chili entry and must be paid via the online registration system no later than November 14, 2019.

Awards will be given to first prize and runner-up in best overall chili, as well as most unique chili. Winners will be chosen by public voting.

Contestants must provide at least six quarts of chili in order to qualify. Contestants must supply their own slow cooker and extension cord. Spoons and sample cups will be provided.

You must disclose in writing and on the day of the event any potential allergens included in your chili, including:

- Milk/Dairy/Lactose
- Eggs
- Peanuts
- Tree Nuts (such as almonds, cashews, walnuts)
- Fish (such as bass, cod, flounder)
- Shellfish (such as crab, lobster, shrimp)
- Soy
- Wheat/Gluten

Contestants may provide garnishes (cheese, hot sauce, onions, etc.), provided they disclose any potential allergens (as listed above).

Contestants are required to check-in, set up, and be ready to start serving their chili no later than 10:45 a.m. on the day of the event.

Public voting will end at 1:30 p.m., and awards will be presented at 1:45 p.m. Contestants must be present to accept their awards.

Contestants are responsible for cleaning their serving area at the close of the event.
